"Surviving Injured Engagements"

This two-day course will provide patrol officers with continuing education in critical injury first aid and injured shooter skills. The course will include a full 8-hour training block on critical injury first aid and a live fire range day focusing on single hand weapon manipulation skills in a variety of challenging conditions. This will be a hands-on, interactive, and demanding two days. Come prepared to push your shooting skills, test your gear, get dirty and problem solve.

Topics to be covered:

- Critical Injury First Aid
 - We will identify potential wound patterns and traumatic injuries faced during patrol operations
 - Provide necessary skills to recognize and rapidly treat life threatening injuries in a hostile environment
- Injured Shooter Procedures
 - We will focus on skillsets and procedures for effectively utilizing the duty pistol while injured and in compromised positions. We will work extensively with single hand weapon manipulations, magazine changes, malfunction clearance, and weapon access issues.

- Eye protection, Hearing Protection
- Note taking materials
- Flashlight (Handheld and Weapon mounted preferred)
