Program: City and county staff are already using AI tools, whether or not there is a policy in place to guide them. This session gives local government leaders a practical, non-technical roadmap for putting AI guardrails in place before a policy gap becomes a public incident: what a workable AI policy actually needs to cover, the first steps to take right away, and a companion look at vendor risk, the often overlooked reality that your MSP, payroll provider, and software vendors are frequently your biggest point of exposure. No jargon, no scare tactics, just what executive leadership needs to know and do.

Speaker: Shawn Waldman is the Founder and CEO of SecureCyber, a cybersecurity firm based in Moraine, Ohio that specializes exclusively in defending critical infrastructure, including water and wastewater utilities, local governments, and finance organizations. Before founding SecureCyber, Shawn spent 19 years in local government, serving as a patrol officer, 911 operator, and Chief of Technology for the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office in Dayton.
